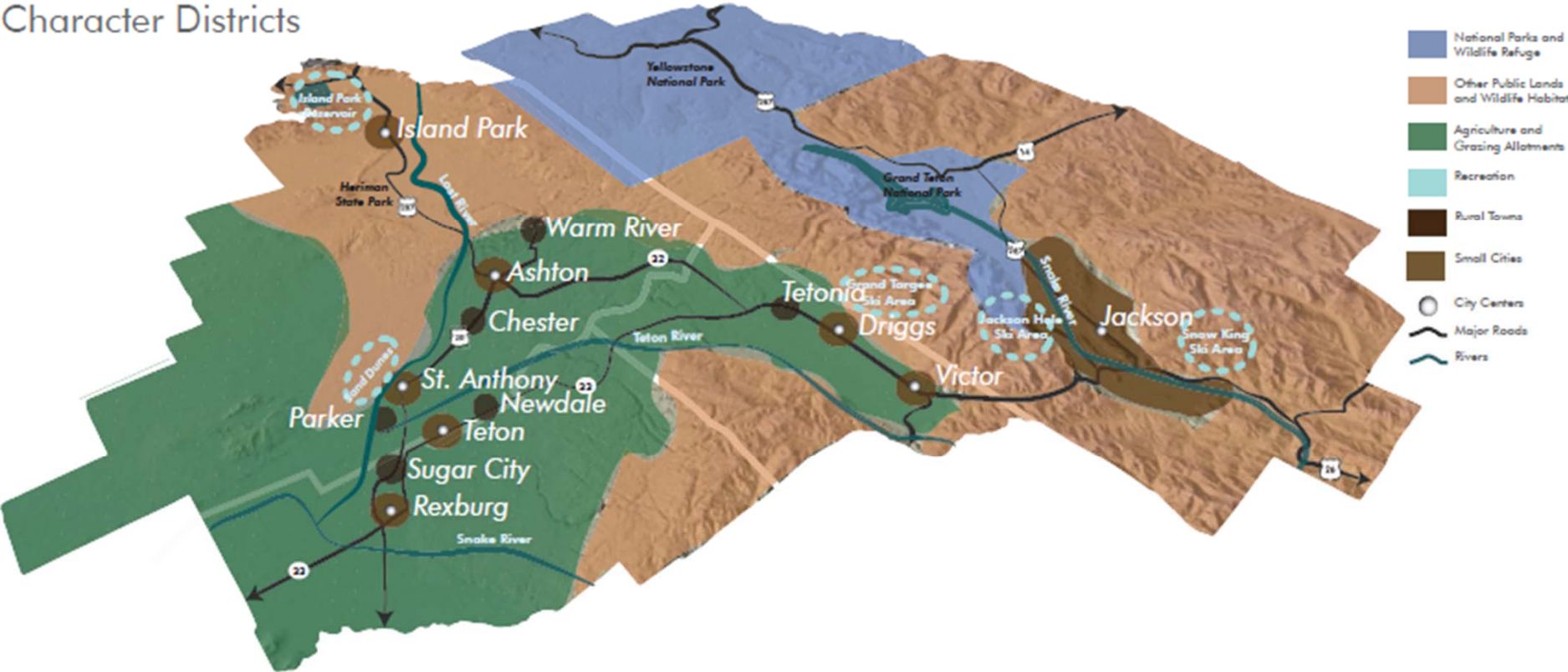


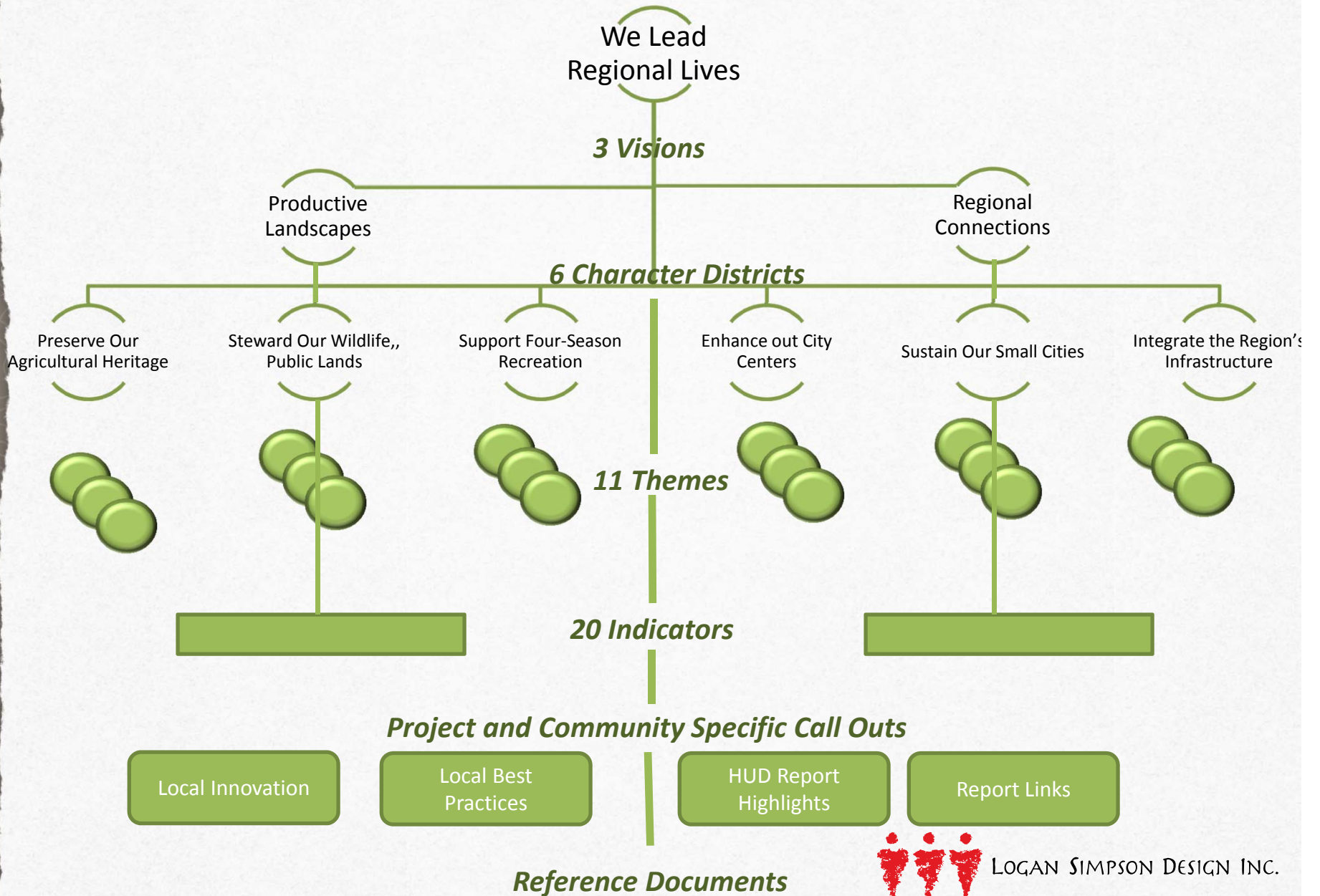

# Guiding the Creation of A Regional Plan

In order to assist in your review of these themes, strategies, and indicators, a definition of each is provided below.

*Character District: A basic structure and underlying concept.*

*Theme: An overarching regional value and topic of interest that supports the framework.*

*Strategy: A plan of action designed to support the theme.*

*Indicator: A metric to monitor the success of each strategy, theme, and framework.*



# About The Indicators

## Theme Indicators

- Align with regional plan themes

- 20 proposed indicators

- Screened for feasibility (data availability, can be replicated, is relevant, understandable)

- Granularity to County level for comparing, aggregating to region

## System Indicators

- Three vital signs for region as a whole

- Cut across economic, environmental, community, collaboration

- Reflect regional priorities
